
Distinguished Educator

8th grade class activities. She also took initiative in being a pilot teacher for the NewLine Smartboards. She spent a year learning how the smartboard works and the best practices for using it. Then, she taught the faculty how to best assimilate them into their classrooms. Mrs. LeSage arrives early to school to help her students in math as well as offering help during recess. I put on the breastplate of righteousness to guard my heart. I am righteous in Jesus.


I put on the belt of truth. I don't believe any lies, and I don't tell any either.
