IS IT RUDE, MEAN, OR BULLYING?

An important take away from this week's presentation is recognizing the differences between when a person is being rude, mean, or bullying.

FYI!

Rude is defined as unintentionally doing or saying something that hurts someone else. Mean is defined as intentionally saying or doing something to hurt someone. What separates meanness from bullying

are the 3 P's -- Power, Purpose, and Pattern. Power = an imbalance in power between the individuals involved. Purpose = the action was done intentionally. Pattern = person continues actions over and over again.
